






Safe Digging Starts With You

If you or someone you know is planning an outdoor project that involves any digging, call 811 before you dig.

Georgia 811 is a nonprofit corporation dedicated to preventing damage to Georgia's underground utilities. Knowing where utility lines are buried can help you avoid injury, service outages, and costly repairs.

Call 811 a few days prior to digging, and you'll be routed to your local call center. Tell the operator **where** you'll be digging, **what type** of work you're doing, and **when**. Within just a few days, your local utility companies will visit your site and mark the location of any underground lines, free of charge.

Each utility type is marked with a specific color:

-  Red for electric
-  Yellow for natural gas
-  Orange for telecommunications
-  Blue for water
-  Green for sewage

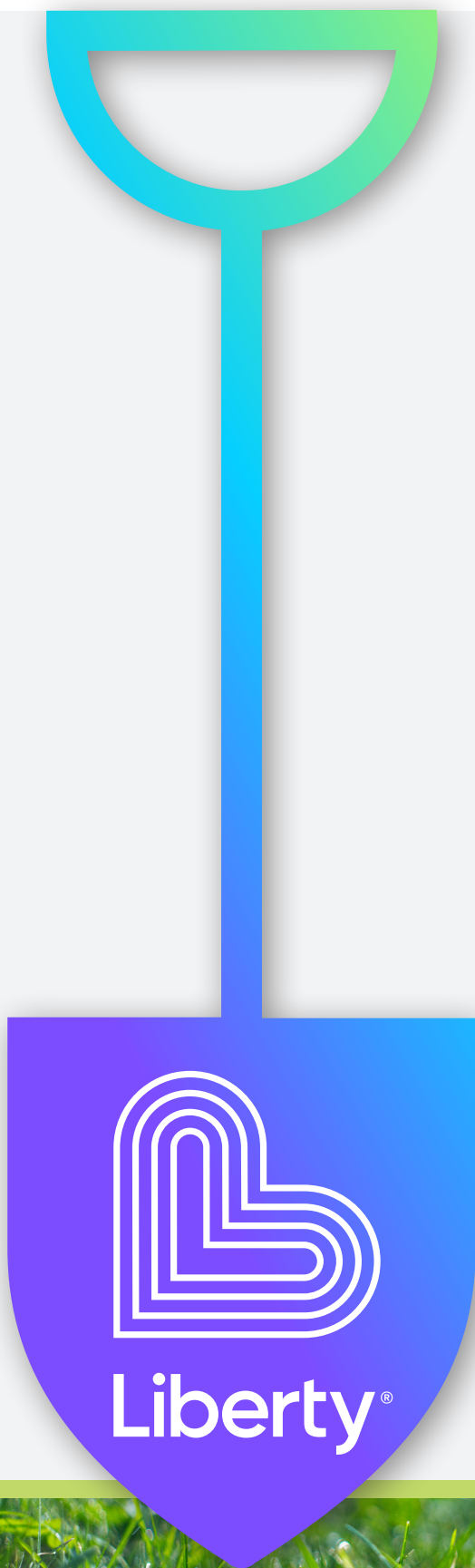
What type of digging activities should be called in?

Anyone planning to use mechanized equipment for excavation, demolition, or similar projects **must** call 811 prior to the start of work. This includes contractors, homeowners, renters, and others.

However, we recommend you call for **any project in which you plan to break ground**. Underground utilities can be damaged while individuals are installing mailboxes, building fences or decks, or even planting trees. Remember, even if your project is small, it's always best to call!

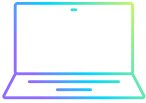

Safe Digging Step-by-step Guide



Notifying Georgia 811 prior to the start of any project that requires digging is a state law. Entering a ticket is fast, easy, and it can prevent dangerous situations.



Online: Visit www.georgia811.com, select "Online Tickets" and then "Submit a Ticket." You will be prompted to answer a few simple questions.

1

Enter your name, email, and phone number

2

Enter the address where you will be digging

3

Select where on the property the digging will occur

4

Answer four questions about the kind of work you are doing

5

Select the start date of your project and indicate duration

Review entered information, and hit "submit" and you're done!

A ticket will be generated and your local utility companies will mark the location of any underground lines in the area you will be digging.



By Phone: Call 811. This toll free number will connect you to your local call center who will ask similar questions to the ones captured online. The process is quick, easy, and FREE!
