Maintaining Chimney and Flues

Maintaining chimneys and flue pipes is an important safety requirement. Now that cooler weather is coming, we recommend customers have a licensed heating contractor inspect their chimneys and flue pipes for safe operation. Chimneys and flue pipes should be checked for soot, residue or any other obstructions that



could disrupt the flow of escaping gases and cause improper venting of carbon monoxide (CO). Visit www.libertyenergyandwater.com for more natural gas safety tips.

Blocked Sewer Line? Use Caution.



Some utilities, like gas, use trenchless technology to install new natural gas lines. Occasionally, these lines can intersect with other existing utility lines.

Under normal circumstances, a natural gas line will remain in a safe condition if it is left alone. However, a

serious safety risk could arise if power equipment is used to clear a sewer service line and causes damage to the natural gas line.

For that reason, if you, your plumber or contractor need to clear a blockage in a sewer service line beyond the outside wall of a home or business with rotating or water jetting (flushing) equipment, it is extremely important to obtain a natural gas line locate BEFORE attempting to clear it. Call 811 for a free utility line locate.

If you do not need to go beyond the outside wall of a building to fix the problem, or if you use a video inspection to confirm there is no natural gas line in the sewer, you do not need to obtain a natural gas locate. Visit our website for more information about sewer safety.

Make Winter Bills More Manageable

Budget Billing is a plan to level out the cost of monthly gas bills over the entire year. The amount you pay each month is based on a rolling 12-month average of your most recent bills. This average is recalculated each billing cycle, which will cause the payment amount to fluctuate
